This recently completed commercial remodel presented the JB design team with several challenges. In order to keep the amount of construction waste to a minimum, we wanted to work within and around the existing parameters, including plumbing and HVAC. With just over 3,000 square feet, the final space plan fits 10 hair stations, shampoo and blow drying areas,

three manicure stations, pedicure and waxing rooms, two dressing rooms, a refreshment bar, bathroom, reception and waiting area, and product display cases.

The single most important feature in any salon is the lighting. Energy efficient overhead fluorescents provide general ambient light while incandescents mounted at eye level at every station provide warm task lighting. By utilizing a mixture of light intensities and

color temperatures, we were able to create the perfect atmosphere for tinting and dying hair. Natural tones used throughout the space, including floors, walls and furnishings further support and enhance the lighting system.

Other sustainable features of this space include the use of natural daylight, the ability to control heat gain with solar screens, and staining the existing concrete floor.
